## Charles Lindberg - by Ed Flanagan

## Herbert Hoover - Grace Shinell

Grace Shinell, writer and historian, presented an exceptionally well informed address on Herbert Hoover. While the focus was on Hoover, attendees also learned a great deal about U.S. political history in general covering the early to mid 1900th Century period.

## Sayyid Qutb - by Marti King

Marti became interested in Sayyid Qutb, "The Father of Islamic Fundamentalism" while taking classes at the Community College. Qutb lived from 1906 to 1966. He had memorized the Quran by age 10. For a number of years he worked for the Egyptian Ministry of Education. In 1950 he got his masters degree from the U of Colorado and returned to Egypt. During his 2 years in the USA he was very upset that there is separation of Church and State. He was a member of the Muslim Brotherhood at the time that it turned violent. In 1954 Nasser banned the Muslim Brotherhood and Qutb was sent to prison for treason. There he wrote the "Signposts Along the Way" which was a call to arms with instructions on how to take over the world. He also wrote a 30 volume "Shades of the Quran" which made the Quran understandable to the masses. He was hanged for treason in 1966.
